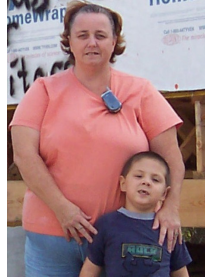


MERRY CHRISTMAS FROM THE 2007 MSN FAMILIES
